



Safety Comes First!

The safety of our student athletes, coaches, and spectators is our highest priority. This document outlines Trinity School's COVID protocols that will be in place during all home games.

COVID Protocols for Players and Spectators:

ALL VISITORS to Trinity School at Edgemere are required to wear masks inside all of our buildings. We will have masks provided for those who do not have one. Players and coaches may remove masks during the match, but masks are **required** to be worn in the bench area.

ALL VISITING ATHLETES AND PLAYERS will receive temperature checks and must complete a COVID questionnaire upon arrival for all teams and spectators before entry is allowed. Any temperature above 100.4 will be asked to wait 5 minutes before entry to reassess temperature. If temperature stays above 100.4 entry will be denied, no exceptions.

Game Ball will be sanitized at halftime and between games. Attendees will need to be outside of the gymnasium for 10 minutes between games for sanitizing protocols.

Visiting teams must communicate any issues or potential exposures before arrival or if symptoms present within 48 hours post-match.

Visitor/Public Restrooms:

Our restrooms in our gymnasium are open for use. Please do not crowd or congregate in restroom areas. Masks are required while in the gym and restrooms.

Admission/Pass Gate:

The Ticket and Pass Gate is located at the North Entrance to the gym. **Our gymnasium is small so we are limiting the number of tickets to two per player.**

- Adults - \$5
- Children (5+) - \$3
- Children Under 5 - Free

Concessions:

We have a diverse concession stand with sodas, Gatorade, and water; as well as food items ranging from chips, candy, and pickles to pizza, popcorn, hot dogs, and Frito Chili Pie. We will be serving as many pre-packaged foods as possible.

Sportsmanship/Fan Behavior:

Trinity School takes sportsmanship very seriously and asks that fans cheer for their teams and do not direct insults or derogatory comments towards players, coaches, or officials. Trinity School Event Manager or Administrator reserves the right to refuse admission or to remove anyone from the premises. In the spirit of cooperation, we ask our opponents to monitor their teams, coaches, and fans. The use of air horns or other loud noise makers are not permitted.
