



TRINITY COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

2022-2023

Updated protocols go into effect Monday, August 15, 2022

We encourage our faculty, staff, and families to **choose whether they and/or their student will wear masks on campus**. Trinity will pivot immediately to a masked community if needed.

Parents should alert the office if an absence is related to COVID-19. In addition, parents and/or students should communicate with their teachers to discuss academic expectations and receive support.

Students, especially those with learning differences, learn best in a classroom environment. For this reason, **Trinity will not offer a virtual learning option as long as the campus is open**. However, in the unlikely event that we must transition to virtual learning for everyone, we will adjust these protocols and notify parents, faculty, and staff immediately.

POSITIVE TEST

EVERYONE, REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS

- *Stay home for five days.*
- *If you have a negative test, no symptoms, or your symptoms are resolving after five days, you can return to campus.*
- *When on campus, you must wear a mask for five additional days unless you receive a negative test.*

If you have a fever, continue to stay home until your fever resolves.

EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19

EVERYONE, REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS

- *No quarantine required.*
- *You must wear a mask while on campus for ten days unless you have a negative test after day five.*

If you develop symptoms, get a test and stay home. Refer to positive test policy.

DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAM
